ALASKA-YUKON EXPLORER & INSIDE PASSAGE 11-Day Land & Sea Journey

DAY 1: Fly to Vancouver

Board your flight this morning to the beautiful city of Vancouver, BC, where you'll be transferred to your awaiting ship at Canada Place. Set sail early this evening, glide under the Lion's Gate Bridge, and enter the scenic wonders of the Inside Passage. (L,D)

DAY 2: At Sea

The fabled Inside Passage is one of the most scenic sea-lanes in the world, and one of the few where deep-draft vessels can sail close to steep mountain walls. The scenery is unbelievable, with forests in a hundred shades of green, tumbling turquoise glaciers, and evocative towns loaded with history, culture and adventure. With most of Southeast Alaska accessible only by boat or plane, the Inside Passage is a lifeline to the outside world. Relax and enjoy a full day of scenic Inside Passage cruising and immerse yourself in Holland America Line elegance. (B,L,D)

DAY 3: Tracey Arm - Juneau

Continue cruising the Inside Passage. This morning you have the chance to explore the stunning beauty of Tracy Arm and the Sawyer Glaciers on an optional excursion. Enjoy the afternoon exploring Alaska's capital. Surrounded by the lush Tongass National Forest and with Mendenhall Glacier at its back door, Juneau offers a wide array of excursions, from a tram ride to the top of Mt. Roberts to a feast at Taku Glacier Lodge via floatplane. Or take a helicopter tour and see the immense Juneau Icefield, and actually land on the glacier! (B,L,D)

DAY 4: Skagway

This morning you will disembark your floating home, and begin the land portion of your journey. Meet your Journey Host and depart Skagway aboard the historic White Pass train to Fraser. Experience the breathtaking panorama of mountains, glaciers, gorges, waterfalls, tunnels and trestles from the comfort of vintage rail cars on this narrow gauge railroad. In Fraser, transfer to Explorer coach for the remainder of your journey to Whitehorse.

DAY 5: Whitehorse - Dawson City

Follow the route of Klondike gold stampeders in style to Dawson City, with an included lunch stop in historic Minto. (L)

DAY 6: Dawson City

Located at the confluence of the Yukon and Klondike rivers, Dawson is now a National Historic Site that has turned back the clock to preserve a rich living history. Meander the wooden boardwalks with costumed townsfolk ready to share their home and its national historic treasures. Today enjoy optional excursions and a nostalgic Yukon River paddle-wheeler cruise aboard the Klondike Spirit. Later, perhaps join the optional excursion to Diamond Tooth Gertie's casino. Inside Canada's first and most unique casino, let Diamond Tooth Gertie entertain you with her unbelievable voice and high stepping Can-Can dancers.

DAY 7: Fairbanks

Your journey continues as you board a short flight bound for Fairbanks, Alaska's Golden Heart City

DAY 8: Fairbanks - Denali National Park

Step back in time at Gold Dredge 8 and strike it rich! Learn all you need to know about gold mining history, and how the dredge works, then try panning for yourself at dredge camp. You are guaranteed to find gold! Then it's off to Denali for a two night stay at this magnificent national treasure. Be sure to keep your eyes on the horizon, because you never know when you might catch a glimpse of Mt. McKinley!

DAY 9: Denali National Park

Today features the unforgettable Tundra Wilderness Tour. This 5.5 hour fully narrated sightseeing excursion is a 43 mile drive into Denali National Park – the very best chance of seeing both the mountain itself and Denali's iconic wildlife (snack included).

DAY 10: Denali - Anchorage

This morning, board the luxurious domed rail cars of the McKinley Explorer bound for Anchorage where you will bid farewell to your Journey Host. Relax and view the scenic beauty of a ride in a deluxe dome railcar. Your railcar's dedicated Car Manager will be your guide during your trip.
