# Alaska-Denali 11-Day Land & Sea

## DAY 1: Fly to Vancouver, British Columbia

Board your flight this morning to the beautiful city of Vancouver, BC, where you'll be transferred to your awaiting ship at Canada Place. Western Canada's spectacular city boasts a multicultural population drawn from all over the world to its scenic location on English Bay. Set sail early this evening under the famed Lion's Gate Bridge, and on to the scenic wonders of the Inside Passage and the Great Land of Alaska (B,L,D)

## DAY 2: At Sea

Relax and enjoy a full day of scenic Inside Passage cruising. Breathe in that fresh, invigorating sea air and feast your eyes on the beauty that surrounds you. Maybe you'd like to pamper yourself in the spa, or pull out that that book you intend to read and cozy up on the teak deck chair on the promenade deck. (B,L,D)

## DAY 3: Ketchikan, Alaska

Alaska's "First Town" is a noted mecca for sportfishing. Ketchikan also boasts Misty Fjords National Monument, colorful Creek Street, the rollicking Lumberjack Show and the world's largest collection of totem poles. Need to pick up something for the Grandkids? Ketchikan's stores are an easy walk from the ship with lots of great shopping in one area. (B,L,D)

## DAY 4: Juneau, Alaska

Juneau, Alaska may well be the most remote, most beautiful and strangest state capital in the United States. Surrounded by water, forest and mountain sights, visitors seeking things to do in Juneau indoors and outdoors can hike a glacier, eat fresh-caught fish on a seaside patio and tour a grand capitol building all in one day. Surrounded by the lush Tongass National Forest and with Mendenhall Glacier at its back door, Juneau offers a wide array of excursions, from a tram ride to the top of Mt. Roberts to a feast at Taku Glacier Lodge via floatplane. Or take a helicopter tour and see the immense Juneau icefield, and actually land on the glacier! (B,L,D)

## DAY 5: Skagway, Alaska

Welcome to Skagway, Alaska, incorporated on June 28, 1900, as the first first-class city in the Territory of Alaska. During the early 1900s Skagway was known as the "Gateway to the Klondike." Here is where the past lives on, where the cries of "gold in the Yukon" still echo from steep canyon walls, where the sounds of barroom pianos and boomtown crowds ring out in the night. A place where the romance and excitement of yesteryear linger around every street corner, every bend in the trail. That place is Skagway! Recommended? A trip on the famed White Pass & Yukon Route Railway, and a stroll through the most interesting Skagway Museum & Archives. (B,L,D)

## DAY 6: Glacier Bay National Park – Cruising Only

Prior to about 1750, Glacier Bay didn't exist. But then the ice retreated, sculpting a whole new landscape. There are many processes still at work in Glacier Bay National Park, the most dramatic of which is "calving" – the phenomenon that occurs when salt water melts the glacier's foundation and huge pieces of ice sheer off the face. Glide through the sparkling fjords as you watch the marine wildlife and listen to the informative color commentary of your National Park Ranger staff. Be prepared for any weather: Pack a hat, gloves, wool or fleece layers, a warm coat and waterproof gear if you want to admire the landscape from the open deck. (B,L,D)

## DAY 7: Gulf of Alaska – Day at Sea

Cruise towards mist-shrouded islands, towering Douglas firs and rank upon rank of snow-gilded mountains. Eagles skim low over the water, competing with humpbacks and killer whales for the area's abundant fish. Glaciers remain a huge draw, of course, frosting mountain ranges and shearing icebergs into the ocean – watch for baby seals resting on them from May to early July! And don't forget to survey beaches for coastal brown bears, which can grow up to three times bigger than inland grizzlies, thanks to all the available salmon. Make sure to pack warm and waterproof gear, along with binoculars, so you can belly up to a railing and enjoy this magnificent beauty. (B,L,D)

## DAY 7: Prince William Sound – Day at Sea

Enjoy a leisurely day cruising north across the Gulf of Alaska and through the pristine waters of Prince William Sound. James Cook entered Prince William Sound in 1778 and named it Sandwich Sound, after his patron the Earl of Sandwich. The editors of Cook's maps changed the name to Prince William Sound, in honor of Prince William, who would later become King William IV. Most of the land surrounding Prince William Sound is part of the Chugach National Forest, the second largest national forest in the U.S.

## DAY 8: Anchorage to Denali National Park

Disembark your ship and join your Holland America Journey Host on the coach to Denali for a 2-night stay. Check into McKinley Chalet with leisure hours to immerse yourself in Denali. You may want to book the optional "Cabin Night" Dinner Show for a fun, Alaska evening.

## DAY 9: Denali National Park

Your morning is free for exploration or perhaps an optional excursion. In the afternoon, venture deep into Denali on the 8 hour Tundra Wilderness Tour, where you'll explore miles of unspoiled habitat. Watch for caribou, moose, grizzlies and Dall sheep plus dramatic Mt. McKinley view points.

## DAY 10: Denali National Park to Anchorage

This morning, board the luxurious domed rail cars of the McKinley Explorer bound for Anchorage where you will bid farewell to your Journey Host. Relax and enjoy the scenic beauty. Your railcar's dedicated Car Manager will be your guide during the trip. Enjoy a gourmet meal on the train as you bid farewell to the Great Land.

## DAY 11: Fly Anchorage Back to Your Home City

Early morning transfer to the airport for your flight back home to the Lower 48. Welcome home!

**NOTE:** All meals are included on the cruise portion of the tour, while no meals are included on the land portion of the tour, except as specifically noted on tour documents.
