Tour fascinating Iceland for four wonderful days – from the sights of the capital city, Reykjavík, to the hot springs and waterfalls of Thingvellir National Park. You'll also stop to enjoy a soak in the famed Blue Lagoon, a natural geothermal spa. Includes all hotels, breakfasts and transfers.

DAILY SCHEDULE

Day 1: Reykjavík, Iceland

Discover the capital of Iceland, Reykjavík, on this three-night, four-day tour of the country's most famous landmarks. On arrival at the airport you will be met by the local guide and then take a city highlights tour before the transfer to your hotel. After check-in enjoy the evening at leisure.

Day 2: Iceland & the Golden Circle

After breakfast (included) at the hotel, depart for a scenic drive to beautiful Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Iceland's most outstanding landscapes. The area is surrounded by mountains and encompasses a vast lava plain of green moss and wild flowers.

Leaving Thingvellir, you will continue to the Geysir hot springs area, where hissing springs and other geothermal phenomena will surround you. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant.

After lunch, continue your drive to Gullfoss Waterfall. The "Golden Waterfall," where the river Hvita drops 96 feet into two falls, is the most famous of the country's many cascades. Next you will visit Kerid Crater, one of the more dramatic of the numerous craters that dot Iceland's landscape. Created by an explosion followed by implosion of its cone, it now has a lake at its bottom.

Return to Reykjavík and enjoy the evening at your leisure, perhaps dining in one of the city's many fine restaurants.

Day 3: Reykjanes Peninsula, Iceland

After breakfast (included) at the hotel. Enjoy some free time to explore the shops and sights on your own this morning. Following lunch (on your own), you will enjoy an afternoon excursion to the Blue Lagoon. This natural geothermal spa is located in the middle of a beautiful lava field. Drive through Reykjavík's suburbs before entering the surreal lava landscape of the Reykjanes Peninsula. The water of the lagoon is 37–39 degrees Celsius (98–102 degrees Fahrenheit), mineral rich, and reputed to have healing properties. The blue color and high lava wall surrounding the lagoon create a unique atmosphere. Enjoy a dip in these warm waters before returning to Reykjavík for an evening at leisure.

Day 4: Iceland

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight home.



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
