#### DAY 1: Depart U.S.A. for Tokyo, Japan

#### **DAY 2: Tokyo, Japan**

There aren't many places on Earth that blend ancient tradition and the ultra-modern quite like Tokyo, where you'll begin and end your cruise and tour. Centuries-old gardens and cobblestone laneways live in perfect harmony with soaring skyscrapers and dazzling neon lights. Get immersed in an unrivalled dining scene, fashionable boutiques, and endless cultural encounters in this ever-evolving city. In addition to its modernization, there's plenty of history to discover. From shoguns to samurai to emperors, Japan's history is rich and fascinating and permeates the walls of its ancient temples, shrines and castles. #### **DAY 3: Tokyo**

Today, join your host for a highlight tour of this beautiful city, visiting Tsukiji Outer Market, Imperial Palace, Asakusa Temple & Nakamise Shopping Street, Meiji Shrine, Omotesando & Harajuku. (B,L)

#### **DAY 4: Tokyo** (Embarkation 5:00 pm)

Enjoy some time on your own, before joining your group transfer to the awaiting Millennium. Experience the cosmopolitan pleasure of Yokohama, Japan's first modern, international port. Settle into your stateroom, and begin to get to know your floating home. Bon Voyage! (B,D)

#### **DAY 5: Mt. Fuji** (8:00 am – 4:00 pm)

On clear days, particularly in winter, Mount Fuji (Fuji-san in Japanese) is visible from as far as Tokyo, 60 miles away. When Japan's highest mountain is capped with snow, it's a picture-postcard perfect volcanic cone. One of the best-known symbols of Japan, this iconic mountain has been considered sacred since ancient times and was even forbidden to women until the early 1900s. As an optional excursion, you may want to ride an aerial gondola and experience heart-pounding panoramic views of Owakudani Valley and Hakone National Park. (B,L,D)

#### **DAY 6: Osaka** (12:00 pm – 8:00 pm)

Osaka, or Kyoto, is a fascinating city with its ancient UNESCO World Heritage Sites (there are 17 in total). Also known as the capital of Japanse culture, Kyoto features mystical temples and ancient shrines. Explore Osaka, Japan's second largest city, and home to ancient weaponry and relics displays. Osaka is a city with precious historical and cultural heritages. Osaka welcomes tourists as a city with advanced technology, refined food culture, and shops with goods from around the world. (B,L,D)

#### **DAY 7: Relaxing Day at Sea**

#### **DAY 8: Fukuoka** (7:00am – 4:00pm)

Japan's Fukuoka Prefecture provides some of the most interesting communities in the country and Dazaifu is no exception. Established in the late 7th century to serve as the administrative center of the entire island of Kyushu, Dazaifu quickly became pivotal for Japan's diplomatic relations and organizing the country's defenses. Today the city is home to over 70,000 residents with a variety of temples and shrines that draw in travelers from around the world. Visit shrines and national museums. (B,L,D)

#### **DAY 9: Busan, South Korea** (8:00am – 5:00pm)

Busan/Pusan is Korea's second largest city. For art buffs, Busan offers several museums and historical buildings. If scenery is your thing, try visiting the Dongbaek Island, or bird watch at the Nakdong river estuary. It is Busan's premier trading port, adjacent to the Korean Straits and Japan, that makes it an international metropolis but its beautiful sea vistas that make it a charming place to unwind. Step back in time at the 1,000 year-old historic city of Gyeongju, visiting the National Museum and Bulguksa Temple. Experience the serenity of Beomeo-sa Temple, climb the Busan Tower in Yongdusan Park or perhaps rejuvenate at Hushimchung Spa. (B,L,D)

#### **DAY 10: Relaxing Day at Sea**

#### **DAY 11: Aomori, Japan** (9:00 am – 7:00 pm)

Aomori Port, the capital of Aomori prefecture, is located on Mutsu Bay, at the northern tip of Honshu. Here, nature and culture fuse as one. The Shirakami Mountains, which embrace the world's largest virgin forest of beech trees, have been awarded a World Heritage Site designation. Reminders of ancient times abound throughout Aomori Port as well, and you can also indulge in the serene atmosphere of the Sannai-Maruyama Ruins, Japan's largest, which are said to have been established around 4,000 to 5,000 BC. Stroll Aomori's premiere Shinsen Ichiba seafood market where restaurateurs hand-pick fresh produce then slurp up delicious ramen noodles at one of its counter restaurants. (B,L,D)

#### **DAY 12: Relaxing Day at Sea**

#### **DAY 13: Tokyo** (Arrive 7:30 am)

Yokohama is often called the Garden City, though its name actually means "City by the Bay." Its waterfront area provides a port to the rest of the world as well as beautiful beaches. The waterfront district has unique arts galleries and boutiques and one of the largest Chinatown areas in Japan. Yokohama is the home of Japan's Central Baseball League and Japan's first coffee shop. There is even an indoor beach with sand and water and waves! The second largest city in Japan, Yokohama is home to 3 million people and is a growing, innovative business center. Its large, accessible port has made it Japan's largest international trading center. (B,L,D)
