# Scenic Switzerland by Train

## 10-day Tour to Switzerland

### DAY 1: Fly to Zurich, Switzerland

Join the group for the overnight flight to Zurich.

### DAY 2: Arrive in Zurich, Switzerland

Check into your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to explore Zurich with the help of the CosmosGO app. Stroll the narrow, cobblestoned streets of Old Town, where almost all of the city's historical sights are showcased. Both sides of the Limmat River running through Old Town are filled with shops, sights and lots of yummy food options. Tonight, meet your Tour Director and get acquainted with your fellow travelers over an included dinner. (D)

### DAY 3: Zurich – Lucerne Area

Board the train for your journey from Zurich to Lucerne. Lucerne is one of Switzerland's most idyllic medieval cities, surrounded by a beautiful lake and nestled amidst snowcapped Alps. The rest of the day is at leisure to discover the delights of this charming city or to join an optional scenic lake cruise excursion. Lucerne is home to the Kapellbrücke, Europe's oldest covered wooden bridge. Worth the view also is Thorwaldsen's Lion Monument, dedicated to the Swiss Guards who protected the Royal House of France during the French Revolution. or to join an optional scenic lake cruise excursion. Later, enjoy an unforgettable evening of traditional entertainment featuring a 3-course feast of local specialties, alphorns, yodeling, and festive Swiss music and dancing. (B,D)

### DAY 4: Lucerne Area – Interlaken – Oberland Bernois Train To Montreux – Lausanne

Depart Lucerne on the Lucerne-Interlaken Express. Cross Brunig Pass en route to Interlaken. The town's unique location, nestled between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz and surrounded by the world-famous Eiger, Monch, and Jungfrau mountains, guarantees unforgettable views. Spend some time strolling through the quaint streets or join the optional excursion to Harder Kulm, where you can enjoy a birds-eye view of the entire Jungfrau Region from the Harder Kulm Mountain. Breathtaking! From Interlaken, take the BLS RegioExpress train to Zweisimmen. Continue on the MONTREUX–OBERLAND BERNOIS PANORAMIC TRAIN for your unforgettable journey to Montreux, then continue to Lausanne. (B)

### DAY 5: Lausanne – Montreux – Täsch – Zermatt

Depart for the delightful Swiss mountain resort of Zermatt. En route, stop to visit the town of Montreux, situated on the shores of Lake Geneva and known as the "Swiss Riviera." Enjoy some free time or maybe join an optional guided excursion to the beautiful Chillon Castle built on a rocky islet. Then continue by train to car-free Zermatt, a resort surrounded by Switzerland's highest mountains – including the celebrated Matterhorn. (B,D)

### DAY 6: Zermatt (Gornergrat Excursion)

An included excursion takes you to the famous GÖRNERGRAT, traveling on board Europe's highest rack railway. The views from its summit are sensational. The Gornergrat (10,000 ft) is one of those places that everyone should visit at least once in a lifetime. The mountain panorama and the glorious view of the Matterhorn are unforgettable. The Gornergrat Bahn was the world's first fully electrified cog railway. Today it is a modern, eco-friendly railway, equipped with a regenerative braking system that generates electricity on the descent and so saves energy. The line leads over dramatic bridges, through galleries and tunnels, across forests of larch and Swiss stone pine, and past rocky ravines and mountain lakes. The rest of the day is at leisure in Zermatt – with a variety of interesting shops, cafés, bars, and narrow streets to explore. (B)

### DAY 7: Zermatt – Glacier Express – St. Moritz

The train journey today aboard the spectacular GLACIER EXPRESS is without a doubt one of the main highlights of the tour. Billed as Europe's slowest express, it's a narrow-gauge train which takes 7½ hours to cover just over 180 miles, at an average of around 24 mph. But you won't mind, as stunning Swiss mountain scenery unfolds outside the train's panoramic sightseeing windows. Enjoy unforgettable views as you make your way through the unspoiled natural beauty of the Alps on the direct route from Zermatt to the world famous mountain resort of St. Moritz, host of two Winter Olympic Games. (B,D)

### DAY 8: Moritz. Bernina Express (Excursion to Tirano, Italy)

Take the BERNINA EXPRESS train (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) to Tirano, a charming town on the Italian/Swiss border, and back for one of Europe's most spectacular and breathtaking train rides. Travel across lofty Bernina Pass via the Swiss Poschiavo area to Tirano in the Italian Valtellina (valley), witnessing an array of beautiful mountain streams, glaciers, and alpine scenery along the way. (B)

### DAY 9: St. Moritz – Zurich

Leave St. Moritz for the journey back to Zurich. This beautiful city offers a unique mixture of attractions as a lakeside "metropolis of experiences." Enjoy some time at leisure today. Last chance for souvenir shopping! (B)

### DAY 10: Zurich

Your vacation ends with breakfast this morning. Join the group transfer to the airport for your flight home. Auf Wiedersehen! (B)
