DAY 1: Fly to Lima, Peru

Enjoy your flight to Lima, Peru today. Upon arrival, check into the Wyndham Lima Airport Hotel, and rest up before your adventure begins.

DAY 2: Fly Lima to Cusco, travel to Sacred Valley

After breakfast, you'll meet your guides for the short transfer to the airport for your 1.25 hr flight to Cusco. Upon arrival in Cusco, transfer to Urubamba at the Sacred Valley of the Incas. On the way, visit the village of Pisac to browse/shop at the colorful Indian market. A wonderful lunch has been prepared for you at Rancho Wayra, where you'll also enjoy an exhibition of Peruvian Paso Horses. Arrive this afternoon in Urubamba and check into your hotel - rest of the afternoon and evening at leisure to adjust to the altitude. (B,L)

DAY 3: Sacred Valley

Rise and shine for a morning buffet breakfast before departing for the Moray Ruins — an agricultural testing ground and testament to the technological advancements of the Incas. From here, visit the Maras Salt Mines, where steeply descending saltpans have been mined since Incan times, then on to the village of Chinchero, where the main plaza and the nearby Inca ruins are some of its many attractions. A delicious lunch awaits you at Casa de Barro restaurant, surrounded by majestic snow-capped mountains and breathtaking Andean landscapes. Return to the hotel for an evening on your own. There are many interesting and excellent restaurants in the vicinity of the hotel and in central Cusco. Enjoy! (B,L)

DAY 4: Sacred Valley - Machu Picchu

After breakfast, transfer to Ollantaytambo train station for a scenic 1 hour 30-minute VistaDome train trip through the Urubamba Valley, followed by a short bus ride up to the breathtaking Lost City of the Incas, Machu Picchu - One of the 7 Wonders of the World! Buffet lunch at beautiful Belmond Sanctuary Lodge. In the afternoon, a guided tour of the archaeological site in small groups. Late afternoon, depart to Ollantaytambo by train. Upon arrival and transfer to your hotel in Cusco. Evening is on your own. (B,L)

DAY 5: Sacred Valley

Enjoy breakfast and the entire morning at leisure to relax and explore on your own. Afternoon, a city tour including: the Plaza de Armas (main square), the Cathedral, Santo Domingo Church (Koricancha), and the surrounding ruins of Puka Pukara, Kenko, Tampu Machay, and the renowned fortress and religious site of Sacsayhuaman famous for its cosmic energy. Along with your group and guides, a delicious Farewell Dinner at Inka Grill Restaurant will cap off your experience in the Andes. (B,D)

DAY 6: Cusco - Lima

After breakfast, depart for the Cusco airport and your late morning flight back to Lima where you will say goodbye to your guides before arriving at Lima's Port of Callo to board the Azamara Pursuit for the next leg of your South American voyage.

DAY 7: Lima

Laid-back, but with layers of history and culture to explore, "the City of Kings" is one of South America's crown jewels. Venture outside the city to discover the famed Nazca lines etched in desert terrain.

DAY 8 - 10: At Sea

Relax and reflect on your journey thus far with a few days of fun at sea. Get a behind-the-scenes look at life onboard with an Insider's View Tour, attend a destination lecture to learn more about your next port-of-call, or just catch up on some reading with the invigorating fresh sea air on the way to the Panama Canal.

DAY 11: Panama Canal

Considered one of the seven wonders of the modern world, the Panama Canal is one of mankind's greatest accomplishments and a must-see for every world traveler. Seeing over 14,000 ships pass through every year, the journey cuts through the Isthmus of Panama and takes about nine hours, as ships are lifted and lowered a total of approximately 170 feet through its three locks.

DAYS 12 & 13: Cartagena, Colombia

Enchanting, romantic, and exuding Spanish Colonial charm, colorful Cartagena is an inviting destination for travel lovers. This walled city holds stunning treasures just waiting to be discovered, such as castles, palaces, and sandy beaches. After a day of exploration, settle into an open air café and watch horse-drawn carriages canter by.

DAY 14: At Sea

Spend the day sailing in style aboard your boutique hotel at sea. Indulge in a treatment at Sanctum Spa, stay ship shape with a class at our fitness center, or lounge the day away on our sunny pool deck.

DAY 15: George Town, Grand Cayman

George Town is more than just a financial hub.
