## Toronto to New York City Niagara Falls – Baseball Hall of Fame The Big Apple

### **DAY 1: Fly to Toronto, Canada**

### DAY 3: Niagara Falls, Ontario - Cooperstown, NY

Enjoy a stop at Niagara Falls State Park, where you can view the Falls from the NY side and grab some lunch from a snack bar or food cart. Later, head south toward Cooperstown, NY, witness the gorgeous colors that make the Northeast US so famous for its fall foliage. Included dinner stop tonight is at Brooks House of BBQ, home of the largest indoor charcoal barbecue pit in the East! (B,D)

### **DAY 4: Cooperstown - New York City**

It's as American as apple pie... today you visit the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum. See collections of baseball artifacts, works of art, literature, photographs and memorabilia which focus on the history of the game over time, its players and those elected to the Hall of Fame. Take your time to explore and learn about the history behind America's favorite pastime. Stroll down Cooperstown's quaint little Main Street and find a place to grab lunch (on your own). Then our coach is headed for New York City! Check into your Times Square Hotel before dinner. (B)

### **DAY 5: New York City**

After breakfast, an Expert Local Guide takes you on a full tour of the city's most famous sights: Times Square, Greenwich Village, the Financial District, Rockefeller Center, Central Park, and Chinatown and more. During your free time in Manhattan, take advantage of all there is to see and do — perhaps a few hours at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, a visit to the Empire State Building, or a Broadway show. Find a great restaurant in this city of great restaurants.

### **DAY 6: New York City**

You may want to skip lunch in anticipation of this incredible meal, served family style. (D)
